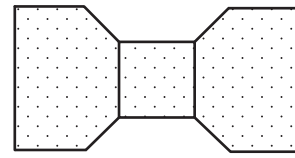
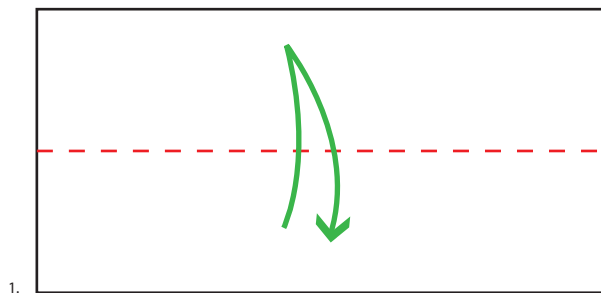


# Traditional Origami Bow Tie



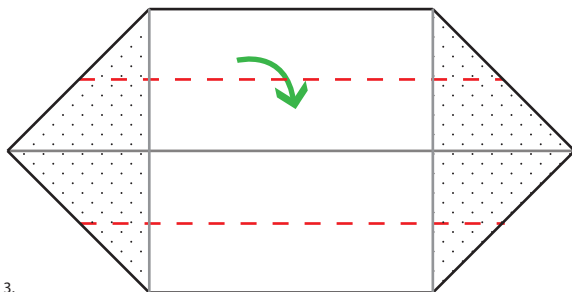
This fun bow can be adapted to wear as a hair clip or bow tie, or left as is it can be used as a gift wrapping adornment.



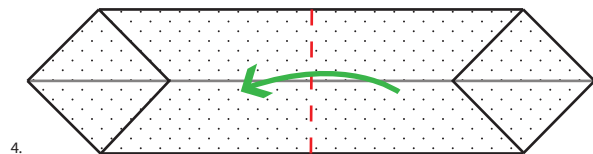
1. **Fold in half, then unfold**



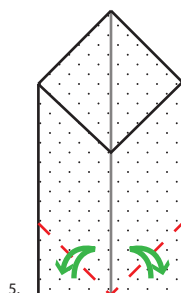
2. **Fold each corner in to meet centre fold**



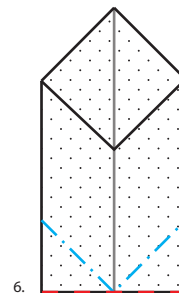
3. **Fold both horizontal edges in to meet centre fold to create a gate fold**



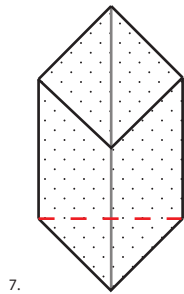
4. **Fold in half so that points meet**



5. **With point pointing up, fold bottom corners diagonally to meet centre, then unfold**

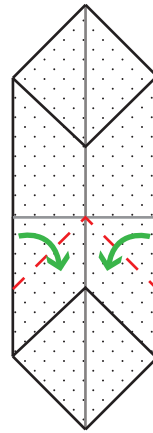


6. **Using existing creases as a guide, fold bottom outer corners to the inside to meet at the centre. You will need to open model a little to achieve this.**



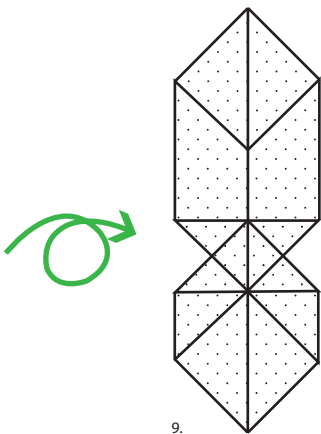

**Fold top point downwards to open model**



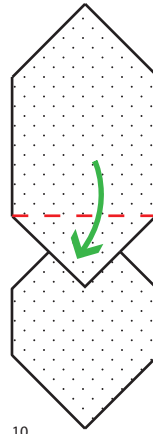

**Fold corners diagonally into centre**



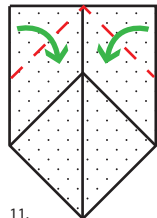

**Turn model over**



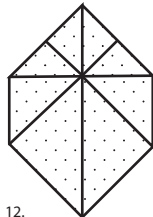

**Fold tip down to meet tip at bottom**



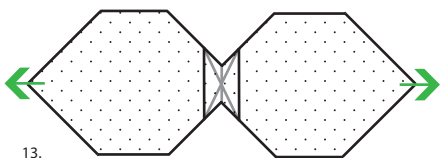

**Fold corners diagonally into centre**

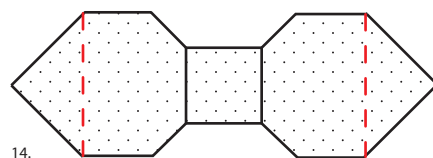

**Rotate 90 degrees, with one flap in each hand, gently pull flaps outward, away from one another**

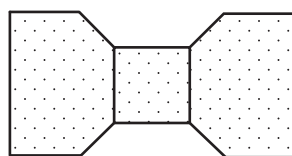
